

The Dassel Township monthly meeting came to order on Tuesday April 9, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Dassel History Center. Present: Supervisors Kevin Rossow, Matt Woetzel and David Isaacson, Treasurer Galen Nyman and Clerk Karin Colberg.

Matt made motion to approve the minutes of the last monthly meeting and it was seconded by David. msc.

Kevin made motion to accept monthly Treasurer's report along with the bills to be paid and it was seconded Matt. msc.

Discussion was held on the following –

Chair – Kevin made motion and Matt seconded it to nominate David as chairperson for one year. Msc.

Recycling – Dave Prieve from Collinwood Township board came to the meeting to talk about the cost of the recycling. The revenue is produced from a Score Grant and amounts to \$10,000.00. In the past the cost of recycling was about \$10,000.00 but this year it will be going about to approximately \$20,000.00. They were how Dassel Township felt about the increase and the program and what direction the 2 Townships should go with this program. Kevin and Matt will try to attend their board meeting on the 3rd Monday of April at 7 p.m. to discuss this further.

738th Bid – We received the tabulation from Adam Thiele on the 5 bids that were received for the 738th project. David made motion and it was seconded by Kevin to accept the lowest bid which was Knife River for \$333,942.50. msc. More discussion was held on making sure that the breakdown and costs of projects going forward of accurate right from the start. Kevin will contact Adam about accepting Knife River's bid.

Spraying – Kevin is still trying to contact the person he worked with last year from Paynesville Coop about the spraying program for 2019.

Sign – It was suggested that we might need to put a "rough road ahead" sign on 705th. We will check with ID Sign and Bob Ruppe for direction.

Fire contract – David made motion and it was seconded by Kevin to approve the fire contract. Msc. The fire department had sent out a survey to be filled out by the Township. The supervisors did this and David made motion and it was seconded by Kevin to appoint Matt Woetzel to the fire board. Msc.

Bike Path – Matt made motion and it was seconded by David to appoint Kevin to the Bike Path board. Msc.

Lindberg – Warren said he will watch the weather and see if there is school on Thursday and Friday of this week when we have another snow storm predicted.

Dust guarding – Orville Anderson attended to discuss the dust guarding. He will be getting bids from 3 companies. We will be including the intersections this year. They will do this after the gravel goes down.

Board of Appeals –The Board of Appeals for Dassel Township will meet at the Dassel History Center on 4/11/19 at 11:00 a.m. Karin will look into our procedures if there is severe weather.

Private assessor – Karin will check with our attorney and the State website for independent certified assessors.
