

The Dassel Township monthly meeting came to order on Tuesday May 14, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Dassel History Center.

Present: Chairman David Isaacson, Supervisor Matt Woetzel and Clerk Karin Colberg.

Guests: Craig Lindberg, Orville Anderson, Erhard Woetzel and Jay Asplin and Pat Foley.

Matt made motion to approve the minutes of the last monthly meeting and it was seconded by David. msc.

David made motion to accept monthly Treasurer's report along with the bills to be paid and it was seconded Matt. msc.

Discussion was held on the following –

Jay Asplin and Pat Foley attended the meeting to present a preliminary plat for Asplin Woods which is located on CSAH #4. Meeker County Planning and Zoning is asking for a letter of comments from the Township on the proposed subdivision. The supervisors advised Jay Asplin and Pat Foley that they would like to wait until there is a final plat before making any comments or decisions. There was not enough information about the road and the lots for the Township to feel comfortable commenting currently.

Recycling – Matt and Kevin attended a meeting with Collinwood Township and after some discussion, David made motion and seconded by Matt to discontinue Dassel Township's participation in the recycling program since it is being abused and that the cost is going up. Msc.

City of Dassel – There will be a City-Wide clean up day on May 18<sup>th</sup>. The City was wondering if we would like to participate as there will be a location by the Dassel Liquor store where people can bring their recycling and a shredder will be available. All for a fee. It is too late to be involved this year but would like to do it in 2020.

738<sup>th</sup> Bid – The contracts were approved by Bob Ruppe and 3 sets of contracts were signed by David and Karin. 2 sets will be returned to Hakanson Anderson.

Spraying – Kevin is still trying to contact the person he worked with last year from Paynesville Coop about the spraying program for 2019.

Lindberg – Craig attended the meeting and said all was going fine. The maintenance of 250<sup>th</sup> is difficult because of the chunks of tar that continue to come up on the road.

250<sup>th</sup> – Discussion was held on the condition of this road which continues to deteriorate. The supervisors will contact our Engineer Adam Thiele to see if he can come out and review the options for this road.

Dust guarding – Orville had three bids and recommended that we go with Central Minnesota Dust Guarding again this year. The intersections and Big Swan road will be included this year along with the private pay which the Township will pay half of. David made motion and Matt seconded to accept Orville's recommendation. Msc.

Private assessor – Karin will check with our attorney and the State website for independent certified assessors.

Next monthly meeting will be Tuesday of the June 11, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Dassel History Center.

David made motion to adjourn the meeting at 12:30 p.m. and it was seconded by Matt. msc.
