NOT ACCEPTED AT COLLECTION:

Electronics, Out-of-County Waste, Business Waste, Unidentified Wastes, Compressed Gas, Explosives, Radioactive Materials, Tires, Car Batteries, Fluorescent or Incandescent Bulbs.

OIL WILL NOT BE COLLECTED (there is a collection site at Cenex)

FLUORESCENT BULBS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THE COLLECTION

Bulbs are now accepted at the Meeker County Transfer Station at no charge. Or contact Meeker Cooperative Light and Power Association, Litchfield Public Utilities, local hardware stores, and Menards & Home Depot stores for additional recycling options for spent fluorescent bulbs.

HHW ACCEPTED FROM MEEKER COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY! Preparation:

- All items must be labeled and tightly capped.
- Items must be kept separately and in original containers.
- Transport items in your car trunk, or ventilate while transporting in a vehicle.
- Wrap aerosol cans in newspaper when caps are missing.
- If containers are leaking, call 693-5200 for packing advice.
- THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR HOUSE-HOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE
