Light 235/Hwy 12 – Clark Moe was present on behalf of Duane and Noni Smith who are requesting that the Township look into adding a light at the 235th/Hwy 12 intersection. The Smiths are seeking better lighting at that intersection because of the bike path crossing the road as your turn off of Hwy 12. The Township will send the minutes from this meeting to Cody Brandt at MNDot requesting their assistance with this matter.

Road Maintenance – Snow removal has gone well. Nothing else to report.

Division of Maintenance - Kevin has revised the Agreement of the Division of Maintenance Responsibilities between Dassel and Kingston Townships. Kari made motion to accept the revised agreement and it was seconded by David. Msc.
