Gravel Quotes: 6000 yards of modified Class 1; (3/4 small rock & 12% clay) (same as last year). John will call McCarthy, Dave will call McNamara and Randy will call Meeker washed sand and gravel, to get bids.

Road project for 746th Ave and 213 St., includes centerline strip. \$156,046.80 is project cost. Thickness is approx. 3/8 thick with approx. 5 year life. At an additional cost they will come back a year

later to fill in big cracks. Project will begin around end of June and end in August. Fahrner Asphalt Sealers Inc. is contractor.

Papers served to Holm for Dahlmann Seed LLC civil case to vacate lots 1,2, 3 and Block 2 (shores of Little Wolf). Court date currently set for April 9, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. Holm is working with Attorney.

From attendees: A couple of community attendees brought up snow removal for this past winter. Explanation we did discuss during our Annual meeting; two members were snow birds. Also talked about edging of road is slipping off, people driving on edge at corners or curves. Will look more closely at 705th Ave during road inspections.

CD at Kensington is coming due in March with rate of 1.5%. Michelle will role into another year. Motioned made by Holm and 2nd by Prieve. Motion carried
