Present: Supervisors: Dave Prieve, John Nowak, Brian Zeglen, Clerk Celia Knoll, Treasurer Brett Oman and three guest. Meeting was held at the township hall and called to order at 7:00 pm, with reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Guest one: Was inquiring any information on land lock property. Answer: NO

Guest two: Resident on 205th St. by Pigeon Lake. Road condition is in terrible shape, unable to drive to the driveway this past winter & spring due to ruts were so deep and road impassible. This spring unable to get horse trailers to place of business stables. Resident would really appreciate township to haul in gravel & keep an eye on the road through the summer & fall to avoid situation faced this past year. Also if Supervisors can get someone to look at culvert, doesn't seem to be working properly.

Guest three: Resident adjacent to north of township hall questioning ownership of driveway between. According to township attorney half of driveway is owned by township and half of driveway is owned by resident. Resident said he has been mowing and clearing snow for a long time now. Supervisors felt if resident can use road as is to get into his back yard. Supervisors stated we hire someone to mow the township area and as far as snow removal, township does not need it cleared.
