Present: Randy Holm, Dave Prieve, Clerk Celia Knoll and Treasurer Laura Holm. The meeting was held at the Townhall.
Guest – John & Pat Von Eschen

Chairman Randy Holm called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Celia Knoll; May minutes were emailed out, then reviewed at meeting. A few changes were made to answers on County Commissioner questions. Motion made to accept by Dave P and 2nd by Randy H. Motion carried.

Treasurer Laura Holm provided financial report for May. Motion made to accept by Dave Prieve, and 2nd by Randy Holm Motion carried.

Guest: Inquired on more details on 213th St by Lake Washington, wanting to know if road would be striped. Answer: No stripping cost is too expensive; cracks and broken areas will get heat surfaced. Question: what about the landing. Answer: DNR is responsible for the landing area.

Old Business

Gravel Hauling: some road bad shape 178th rough from hauling, possibly starting too early this year? Plans to grade after rain.

Dust Control: Randy will contact Central Minnesota Dust Control with spreadsheet containing names & addresses to get on their list to begin.

Received painted picture of Township Hall, which is hung for residents to view. A Thank You message was sent to artist Elynn Lepel.

Skimming gravel off roads, will continue to monitor area

Recycling bins over flowing, will continue to monitor to see if there is room for a few more bins.

New Business

Spring road inspections will happen May 19, 2021.

New resident contacted Randy H about concerns with lots of traffic going past their house. Randy explained the township does not do anything with amount of traffic. John N will monitor volume.

Randy received call from person living on County Rd 6, wanted township to replace her cars struts.... Randy referred her to person in charge of construction.

Knife River trucks are using 190th St. without permission, Randy contacted County, gave approval for empty trucks only.

200th St. has problem with fast traffic on road while children are playing outside. Laura H will look for a sign that will be used as a warning that “children are at play” to see if that helps.

Question about need for culvert on 185th by Lake Jennie. Supervisors reviewed and there was no need for a culvert in this location. Randy to contact owners.

Bills for payment: Clerk presented bills to be paid, checks 2627 - 2631 total of \$81,477.33. Motion by Dave P and 2nd by Randy H to pay bills. Motion carried
