

The Dassel Township monthly meeting came to order on Tuesday June 11, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Dassel History Center.

Present: Chairman David Isaacson, Supervisors Kevin Rossow and Matt Woetzel, Treasurer Galen Nyman and Clerk Karin Colberg

Guests: Warren Lindberg, Orville Anderson and Mike Housman.

David made motion to approve the minutes of the last monthly meeting with corrections to date and it was seconded by Kevin. msc.

David made motion to accept monthly Treasurer's report along with the bills to be paid and it was seconded Kevin. msc.

Discussion was held on the following –

Graveling and Dust guarding – The gravel is being done this week. Warren is flagging where gravel is needed. Dust guarding will start when the gravel work is done. They need a week notice to start. Matt made a motion and it was seconded by Kevin to dust guard 250<sup>th</sup>, the Big Swan Road, portions of 738<sup>th</sup> and all intersections and private pay. Msc.

Mike Housman – He attended the meeting to see how the Township was doing and how our maintenance program worked out with all the snow that we had over the past winter. He also informed the board that the County Board of Appeal is meeting tonight and that the County Assessor was going to ask the County Board of Appeal to change the decision made by Dassel Township on Dassel Rod & Gun Club. Members of the board will try to attend.

Recycling – Kevin reported that he had been contacted by the County Administrator, Paul Virnig, about the Township recycling. There will be a meeting on June 17<sup>th</sup> at 8:15 a.m at the recycling site. It will include City of Dassel, West Central, Collinwood Township and Dassel Township along with Paul Virnig. Kevin will attend the meeting.

Lindberg – Warren will work on patching and fixing the blow outs where needed on 258<sup>th</sup>, 240<sup>th</sup> and 705<sup>th</sup>.

Spraying – Kevin had talked to the people that sprayed for Dassel Township in 2018. They will probably start after the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and continue with the program that was started last year.

Asplin Woods – The preliminary plat was left for the board meeting. It still does not include the correct information. David made the motion and it was seconded by Matt that the board needs to see the final drawing of the preliminary plat which has to show the round about and exact position of the road and where the exact location of the roads and/or driveways will be on 250<sup>th</sup> before a decision can be made so that Dassel Township can present it to their attorney and engineer for final approval. Msc.

Private assessor – Karin will check with our attorney and the State website for independent certified assessors.
