The Dassel Township monthly meeting came to order on Monday, June 14, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. at the Dassel History Center.

Present - Chairman Kevin Rossow, Supervisors David Isaacson and Matt Woetzel, Treasurer Galen Nyman, and Clerk Karin Colberg.

Guests – Orville Anderson, Larry and Mike Murphy, Renita Moe, Randy Hed, Deven Lundin, Kyle Acker, Erhard Woetzel and Shayna St Pierre

David made motion to approve the minutes of the last monthly meeting and it was seconded by Matt. msc.

Matt made motion to accept the monthly Treasurer’s report along with the bills to be paid and it was seconded David. Msc.

Discussion was held on the following –

Timm Gabrielson – Received a letter from the DNR stating that it was not their jurisdiction. Matt will call Timm and suggest that he contact the Meeker County Conservation Department.

Dust Guarding – Orville said they would start right after the roads were graveled and graded. It should be Thursday of this week.

City of Dassel – Received an updated of the annexation ordinance and we will have our attorney look it over.

Road Maintenance – Discussion was held on making the working relationship between the board and Murphy Construction. A letter was received from Mike about whether they should continue to work for Dassel Township. The board will take it under advisement.

Blow outs – Matt said he thought the supervisors should all look over the roads and see what needs patching. Matt will take the 708th and down to Sportsman’s Park, Kevin will check 233rd and 273rd and David will talk to Lindbergs about doing the patching.

RR crossing – Township received a letter from the State about funds that are available for updating the safety on some crossing. One is in Dassel Township. The board decided not to participate at this time.

Driveways – Virgil Anderson would like to add a driveway. It will need a culvert. Matt will talk to him.

Renita Moe – Attended the meeting to ask several questions. She inquired about the dust guarding and decided not to do it this year. Also wondering about the gravel/grading on her road and was told it would be down this week. She was concerned about the condition of the recycling area and was told to contact Collinwood Township. Several other questions were things that she should contact the County about.

Devin Lundin – Deven and Randy Hed were there to get a final sign off on their rezone and replat for property on 273rd.

Kyle Acker – Attended the meeting to ask about the chip seal that will be done on 250th. He was concerned about the longevity of the product. He wondered if the Township should wait until they can afford to put down asphalt.

Shayna St. Pierre – She had questions about putting a culvert on their property on the east side of 708th on Lake Washington.

Chip Seal – 2 quotes were received Allied Blacktop Company for \$124,992.65 and Asphalt Surface Technologies for \$149,295.40. The board decided they would like to have a little more time to look over the quotes and companies.

The meeting was left open to continue discussions not completed at the regular meeting. The meeting will reconvene on June 21, 2021 at the Dassel History Center at 8:00 p.m.

The meeting continued at 8:05 p.m. on June 21, 2021 at the Dassel History Center.

Orville Anderson was present to talk about the dust guarding. He has not heard from Central Dust Control. David made motion and Matt seconded to give Orville till noon on the 22nd of June to hear from them otherwise he should call Crow River Con. Msc.

Kevin called Andrew from Hakanson Anderson to review the chip seal quotes. He said both companies would do good work. Matt abstained from voting because of conflict of interest. David made motion and it was seconded by Kevin to have Allied Blacktop Company do the chip seal project. Msc.

Matt had information from Meeker County Soil & Water concerning Timm Gabrielson's property. Kevin will talk to with Joe Norman at Soil & Water about the culvert.

Kevin made motion and it was seconded by Matt to adjourn the meeting at 9:25 p.m. Msc.
