**Present:** Supervisors Randy Holm, John Nowak, Dave Prieve, Clerk Celia Knoll, Treasurer Laura Holm. This meeting was held at the Collinwood Township Hall. In attendance was Henry Brausen from B&S Trucking, Jody Danielson and Dot Halvorson. **Chairman:** Randy H called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. With the Pledge of Allegiance recited.

**Clerks Report:** June minutes was sent to board for prove reading prior to meeting. Under New Business, clerk stated Fahrner will be working on filling in cracks in road. Changed to Fahrner has completed filling in cracks. Motion made to approve by John N and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave P to accept report: Motion carried.

**Treasurer Report** Laura H presented report. Received 2<sup>nd</sup> ARPA fund of \$61,198.05 which will show on next month report. Motion made to approve by Dave P and 2<sup>nd</sup> by John N to accept report. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

**Recycling:** Jody Danielson shared feedback on residents wanting recycling back. Wanted to know if it was possible to share recycling with another township and only have it set for a certain day of the week. Resident asked about sending letter to residents to inform them of their options. Randy checked into other townships and they are having similar problems. Randy will review to see what options and locations are available to Collinwood Township residents.

**Election Judges:** Election Judge training is happening with all Judges signed up.

**Road Maintenance:**

- Culvert installation on 705<sup>th</sup> Ave, is complete with billing sent to resident.
- 190<sup>th</sup> St is toward completion, waiting for final layer.
- Discussion with B&S Trucking total loads and yards per load. Up to date payment made.

**New Business:**

Supervisors received County Ditch 15 repair maps.

Clerk received MATIT liability letter in regards to only plowing public roads for insurance purposes.

**Road Maintenance:**

- 190<sup>th</sup> St blacktop 2010, used ground up existing tar. Motion made by Dave P and 2<sup>nd</sup> by John N to continue to fix area for \$13,400.00. Motion carried.
- Dust Control received calls that roads were being graded after dust control application. Supervisor informed resident application will resurface.
- 173<sup>rd</sup> St, tree cut down.
- Resident living on 746<sup>th</sup> Ave asked if township still on budget for 2023 to redo coating since it was the first street to try the slurry mix and never did get the cracks filled, plus it is beginning to wear thin in some places. No – Supervisor explained the budget is not there, had to be used money for other projects. Currently trying to maintain black top in township without breaking the bank.

**Mileage –** Federal guidelines changed as of July 1, 2022 from .585 to .625 per mile.

Township received public hearing letter on July 12<sup>th</sup> on resident moving more than 10 cubic yards of material at shoreline. Information sent from Clerk to Supervisors via email.

**Bills for payment:** Clerk presented bills to be paid, checks 2727-2735 total of \$ 79,653.69. Motion made by Dave P and 2<sup>nd</sup> by John N to pay bills. Motion carried.

No other business, motion made by John N and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave P to adjourn at 9:00 p.m. Motion carried
