Discussion was held on the following –

273rd Stone Bridge – Property owners that live on 273rd attended the meeting to talk about their concerns with the condition of the bridge and washing away of the area around the bridge. There is a gap between the railing and the road that is quite wide. Supervisors will look at the area to see if there is a way to divert the water away from the bridge. They will also check with the County about inspecting the bridge.

Gabrielson culvert – Our attorneys received an order remanding appeal from Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources stating that they remand to Meeker SWCD District Board of Supervisors or their delegate the WCA petition for appeal regarding the No-Loss decision for Timm Gabrielson.

New general obligation of indebtedness – David made a motion to adopt Resolution 2023-8 awarding the sale of a general obligation certificate of indebtedness, Series 2023A for \$700,000.00 at 4.25% interest to be paid back at \$43,000.00 in February and August each year for 10 years. Msc.

240th Micro Surfacing Project – It should be completed in October.

240th/708th – Needs more patching. Knife River will do when they do the 240/730/5th Street project.

738th – Engineers advised to hold off repairing the cracks until early spring with the temperature is colder.

Bike Path – David made a motion and it was seconded by Kevin that Dassel Township is not in favor of extending the bike path to the Darwin Ski Hill. Msc.

233rd – Resident would like to have more 30 mph speed limit signs on the road due to the increased speed and traffic on the road. Kari will check with ID Sign and see if this is possible.
