Minutes from the September meeting were read but will be approved at the next meeting with the addition of the October 19th continuation minutes.

Kari made motion to accept the monthly Treasurer’s report along with the bills to be paid and it was seconded by Kevin. Msc.

Discussion was held on the following –

Chad Miller -He and his neighbor Joyce Aakre would like to see the dead-end of 249th (off of 729th) vacated. The supervisors will find out what the procedure is for doing this and get back to him.

Justin Wendroth – He wants to put in a mound system at his property at 27381 742nd Ave which will be in the road right of way. The supervisors will look at the site on Wednesday and 8 a.m. to see if it can be approved.

John Dahl – He is concerned about the run off to the west of his property at 72398 273rd where the water continues to run down the hill and wash over the bridge and deposit material in the ditch. Kevin will take a look at this and see if anything can be done this year or if it will have to wait until next year.

Road Maintenance – Jim McCarthy had information on reclamation equipment and contractors. Kevin will contact them to see if we can get 692nd/250th dug up and reclaimed. We would like to see this get done this fall. Rip rap on 240th will be done this week. He has added gravel and grade the Alberts property. The board asked Jim if he could separate out the extra grading that has been done on the road past Summit Hills because of the City road being detoured all summer.

738th Project – The project has been completed except for the striping.

692nd/250th 2021 Otta Seal Project – A conference call was held between Kevin Rossow, David Isaacson, Michelle Weinberg, Jeremy Swenson and Peter Capistrant and Richard Shepherd concerning the performance bond.

Jeff Peterson – Kevin Rossow received a certified letter from Jeff discussing the condition of 692nd/250th. He attended the meeting to talk about his continued concerns on the condition of his road. The supervisors told him that they were going to try to get the road reclaimed and in better condition in the next couple of weeks.

Signage – Kari had pricing for several types of signs that could be used to slow the traffic down on 240th from Cty Rd 4 going east. It was decided to purchase 2 sign “Begin reduced speed ahead”.

Kingston Township – A letter was received from Kingston Township stating that they want to terminate the Agreement of the Division of Maintenance Responsibilities with Dassel Township effective 60 days after October 4, 2022. Kevin will talk to the Kingston Township supervisors and also Meeker County.

Election – The primary election will be held at the Dassel History Center for Dassel Township residents on November 8th, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Karin will have election judges lined up and board will set up the night before after monthly meeting.
