Discussion was held on the following –

Road Maintenance – Jim McCarthy reported there was a pile of dirt close to the road on 748th off of 240th. David will check on this and request the owners remove the dirt from the roadway. Matt made motion and seconded by David to rip/rap the area on 240th by the swamp and file the hole on the north side. Msc.

Swan Lake Bluffs – The Dassel Township board has reviewed the preliminary plat for Swan Lake Bluffs and do not have any concerns with the plat. Matt made motion and it was seconded by Kevin to accept the plat. Msc.

280th – The supervisors will look at the turn around and measure the area to see if the boulders are in the right of way.

Chip Seal – Kevin had a voice message from Andrew, our engineer, stating that he and someone from Allied had looked at the road. They recommend an additional sweep to remove excess aggregate and also clean up the shoulders. Kevin will call Bob Ruppe, our attorney, to find out what the Township should do at this point. David and Kevin plan to have a conference call with Bob.

743^d – There are boulders in the ditch/edge of lawn that maybe need to be removed for snow removal and safety.

David made motion and it was seconded by Matt to adjourn at 8:10 p.m. Msc
