Chip Seal – Because of the condition of the road, any decision on the road or payment is on hold until it is investigated more with our attorney.

743rd – A letter will be sent to the homeowner of the property that has boulders in the right of way requesting that they be removed.

American Rescue Plan Act – The Township received \$81,849.47 in funds. We have 3 years to use the funds as required by law.

Clark Moe – Clark contacted Kevin about the possibility of the Township assisting Spring Lake in the reclamation of the water. It was decided that would not be possible at this time.

Tom Kvistad – Requesting the supervisors approve his road that is now completed.

Polling Place Designation – David made motion and Matt seconded it to designated by resolution that Dassel Township’s polling place for the next calendar year will be at 901 1st Street, Dassel, MN, Meeker County Minnesota which is the same as in the past. Msc.
