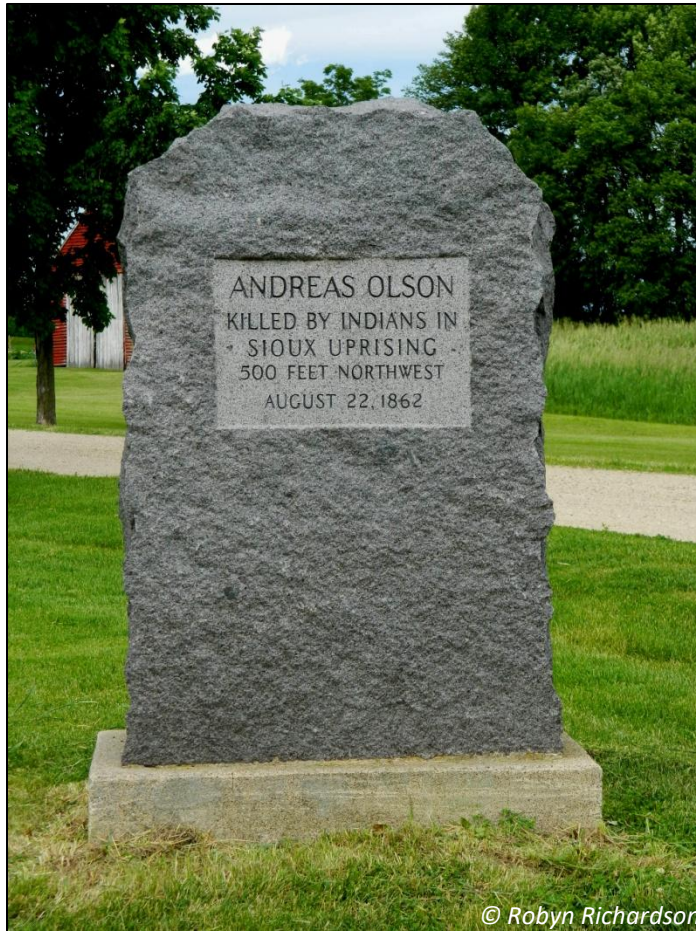


Anders Olson

August 22, 1862



Marker Location: *Six miles southwest of Litchfield on Meeker County Road 23.*

Andreas Olson was killed and scalped in Ellsworth while salting his cattle on Sept. 22, 1862. He was buried in the Ness Church Cemetery.

was left behind. The remaining two men made it to Hutchinson safely. The next day a group of men went out to find the bodies of the Cross and Sanborn. Sanborn had suffered a blow to the head with a grub hoe. The Indians left his body where he had fallen.
