


LAKE KORONIS REGIONAL PARK

Are you tired of campgrounds where you can see and hear everything your neighbors do and say? Do you enjoy wooded, shaded areas? Do you enjoy your privacy? Do you like to relax in a natural atmosphere? Do you like to fish, water ski, or swim?

If you answered yes to the above questions, then the Lake Koronis Regional Park and Campground is for you!

The Lake Koronis Regional Park and Campground consists of 3 cabins, 32 RV electrical sites and 8 non-electrical tent sites. The sites are private, wooded sites and each contain a picnic table and fire pit. Water is available within a few feet of each site.

The playground area and shower house are both located in the center of the campground. The shower house has hot water and flush toilets (handicap accessible).

The playground area is designed for the enjoyment of all ages. There are swings, tetherball, basketball, horseshoes, shuffleboard, and a new modern-playground for young children.

Located across the road from the campsites, you will be able to enjoy our ballfield, volleyball, peaceful walks on our nature trails to the lookout tower, or an afternoon at the beach.


The beach and picnic area are within a two-block walk of the campsites. This area offers a new modern playground for children, a large picnic area with a shelter that is available to rent for special occasions, and a volleyball area. The sandy beach and

cool waters of Lake Koronis invite you for a refreshing swim.

About one-fourth mile from the Lake Koronis Regional Campground is the boat landing. You can enjoy boating, skiing, and fishing on Lake Koronis. Lake Koronis is well-stocked with walleye, northern, sunfish, crappies, and bass.

While you are staying at the Lake Koronis Regional Park and Campground, you may want to take in some of the area's activities such as: golfing, miniature golf, water ski shows, antique shops, historical museum, and small town fairs.

Lake Koronis Regional Park and Campground Rules

1. All campers and guests must register.
2. All visitors must register in office and park in visitor parking area before going to campsite
3. Visitors must leave by 10:00 p.m.
4. Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.
5. Any excessive/disruptive noise and you will be asked to leave without a refund.
6. Children and teenagers must be at your campsite (not roaming the campground) during quiet hours.
7. Radios off at 10:00 p.m.
8. No bike riding through campsites or playground area after dark.
9. Keg beer, loud parties, and excessive drinking not allowed.
10. Do not move fire rings.
11. Please burn wood and paper only. **DO NOT BURN** plastic, styrofoam or green treated lumber.
12. Please keep campsite as clean as when you arrived.
13. No chopping, cutting or carving on trees, picnic tables or campground property. Firewood is sold during office hours, 9 a.m. - 9 p.m.
14. Pets must be leashed and attended at all times. Clean up after your pet. Only people and pet friendly dogs allowed. **NO PETS IN CABINS.**
15. Checkout time is 2:00 p.m.
16. Speed limit is 10 miles per hour.
17. No 4-wheelers, dirt bikes, or golf carts.
18. No refunds due to weather.
19. We reserve the right to evict anyone, without refund, who creates a disturbance or nuisance, or endangers the safety of others.
20. Please respect the park, campground and your fellow campers. If you have a problem with someone/something, report to the office immediately.
21. Please place your garbage in the dumpster.
22. Please recycle your cans and bottles. We have recycling barrels for plastic, glass, and aluminum cans.
23. Please clean your fish in the fish-cleaning house. Leave fish remains in proper area of fish cleaning house, as we will dispose of them.
