Veterans Benefits

■ COMPENSATION CLAIMS

Benefits for veterans who are disabled from an injury or disease incurred or aggravated during military service.

■ PENSION CLAIMS

Benefits to veterans who are permanently and totally disabled or are over the age of 65. Must have served at least 90 days or more of active duty with at least one day during a recognized war period.
